



How to measure your kitchen space

When you come in for your design session we will need some measurements to work with. If you have legible house plans you can bring these rather than having to remeasure.

Don't worry marking existing cabinets unless you have a built in pantry or hot water cupboard that has to stay.

The measurements that you supply to us do not need to be accurate to the last mm or cm as we would never manufacture from these. We always do a professional site measure prior to putting your kitchen into production.

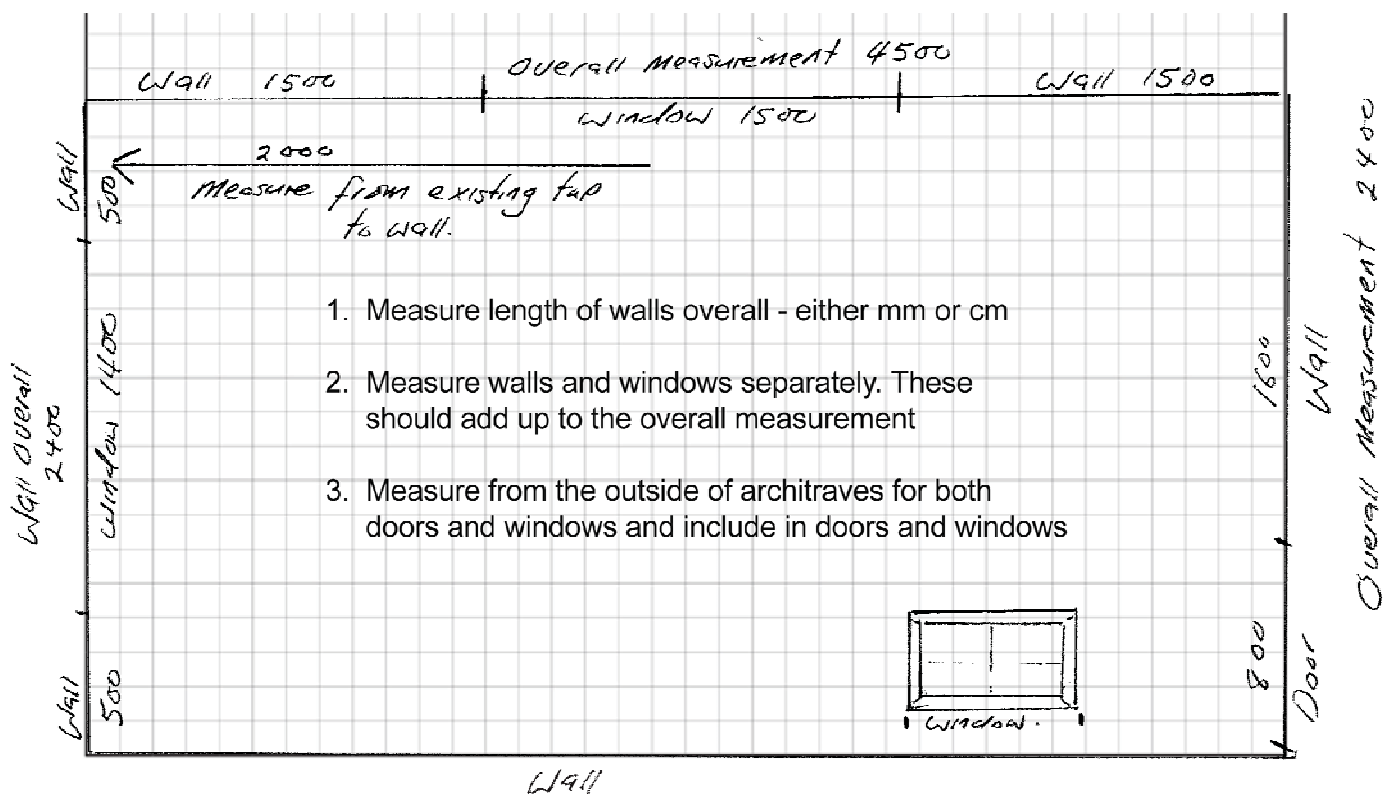

This is particularly relevant if you are doing major renovations or removing walls.

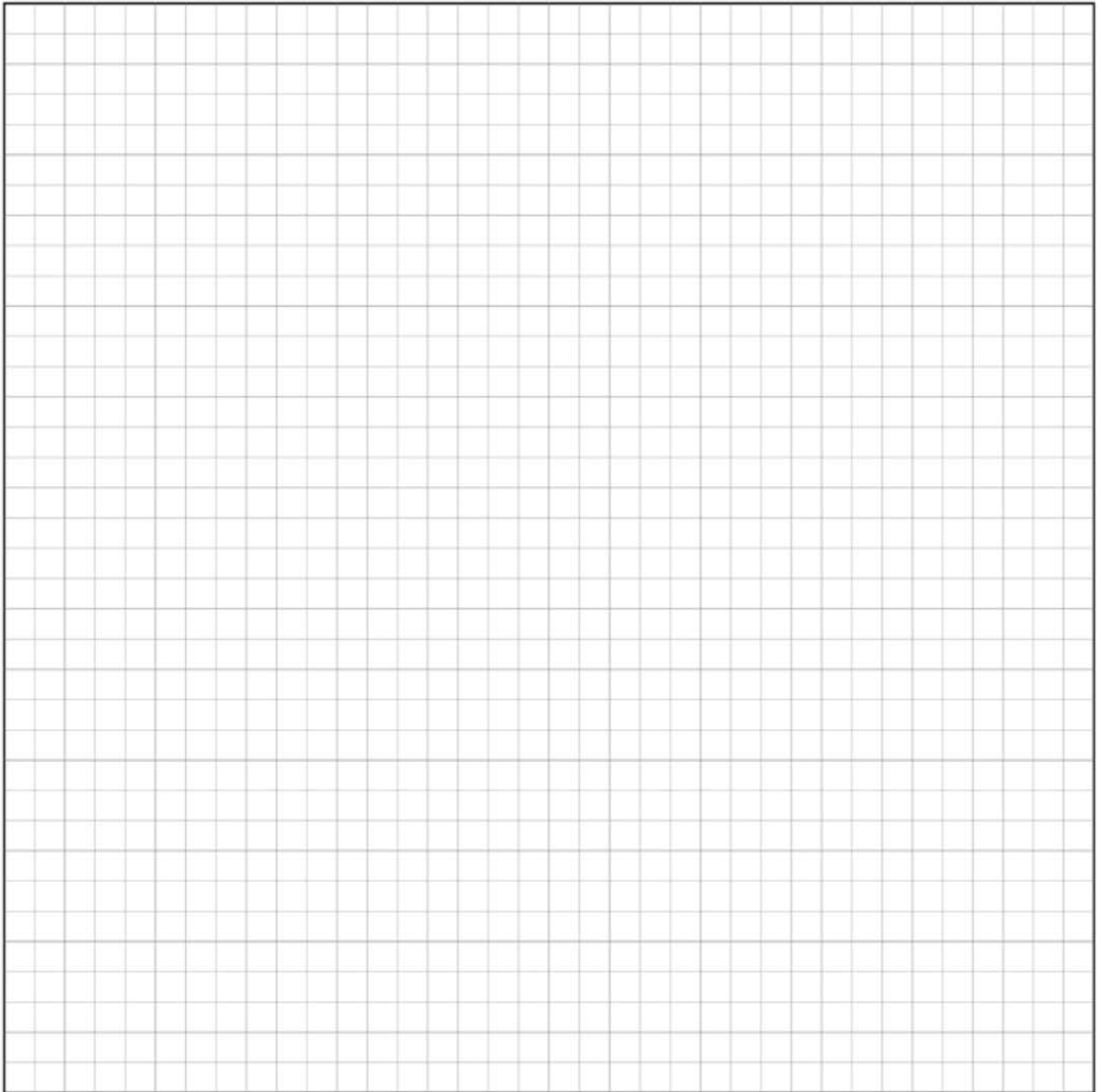
Below is a typical kitchen measure that a client would bring in. Remember it doesn't need to be a masterpiece, just sufficient information for us to come up with a concept.
